- **Review of Minutes:** Meeting called to order by LTJBSA President, Paul Vichroski. A motion was made to accept the June 8, 2022 meeting minutes unanimously approved.
- Treasurer's Report:Our Treasurer, Bob D. was not in attendance. He provided Paul V. with 3 months
of reports (June-August). June and July show typical expenses. Bob will take care
of moving money from the concession account to our operating account.

Carly advised that our credit card sales were fabulous – about 60% of sales were on credit cards. We brought in some additional funds by using the mobile reader. During softball and BR tournaments, we brought in about \$200/night on the mobile reader alone. Parents seem happy with these new features. We would like to try to keep our concession prices where they are, but if food prices rise, we may need to adjust.

A motion was made to accept the Treasurer's Report – unanimously approved.

Babe Ruth

Baseball:Paul V. gave the Babe Ruth Report. We hosted the 14U tournament. The kids
had a great time. Our ladies here knocked it out of the park. Jack was our emcee.
We had a ton of community support and sponsors. Atlantic Shore won the title
and went on to the World Series. We had a nice turnout for the summer season
with 15-20 kids and are rolling right into fall ball practice. Our first game is
tomorrow on Pezzicola. We have about 20 kids signed up for Fall Ball.

Little League

	A motion was made to accept the Little League Report – unanimously approved.
Softball:	Jake Zalaznick, VP of Softball, gave the Softball report. Summer was great. The 11U girls won the District tournament and then played in a 12U tournament the following week with three 12 y/o girls. They made it to semi-finals. We had about 30 girls in attendance for the first couple weeks of the summer SB program. Our Fall Ball program is starting soon with about 30 girls signed up.

Travel:	Dave S. gave the Travel Report. We have a new 8U team and are looking to add a couple more kids. We will have two 10U Thunder teams. Tryouts were held last weekend and 18 kids showed up. The 12U team is playing in a tournament in the beginning of October. Ken M. updated us on the rising 15's. They played in a 5 day tournament in Staten Island at the end of July. They are playing one game per week and scheduled to play in several tournaments. Their first two games last weekend were no hitters and they won the tournament.
	A motion was made to accept the Travel Report – unanimously accepted.

New Business:	Paul V. advised that we need volunteers for a LTJBSA table at Lawrence's Community Day (Sunday, October 2 nd).
	The Snack Shack Express will return in the spring.
	Paul V. and Paul A. had a meeting with the Township, Kevin Nerwinski, and the representatives from the football program. There was a discussion about who actually owns the building/equipment. It was determined that everything belongs to LTJBSA. The Township gave us the frame to the building, but all labor and supplies were donated. All equipment was purchased by us. If football wants to use it, they have to sign a lease agreement, give us a security deposit, and pay a fee. They have not made any arrangements to use our facilities, so the kitchen and bathrooms are off limits. We even offered to run the Snack Shack for them and give them a portion of the proceeds, but they did not agree.
	The Township has agreed to replace the flooring in the bathrooms over the winter.
	The Township will provide a schedule for when work on the field conversion/bathroom flooring will begin.

They never recovered and played flat during LL.However, this same group went in Aug to play on the Beach at Wildwood as a travel team, and played well (fun tourney, thanks to Paul V for driving down and supporting the boys - they were very honored he was there).

Fall Ball

Registration opened August 1. We have about 60 boys and 30 girls playing. \$50 registration fee. 6 weeks, 1 night a week, a mixture of skills building and scrimmages.

Challenge this fall is we don't have a home for our 50/70 teams. Anxiously awaiting the Twp's conversion of Hughes, but as of now the 11/12us have no real place to practice weeknights.

Sponsors

For Fall Ball - NJ529 is back (\$2000), as is Meiji Panda \$1100) and NJ Dept of Mental Health (\$35).

We launched our Sponsor Drive 2023 across all of LTJBSA. Any family that brings us a new sponsor will get a \$25 credit towards next year's registration fee. All info is on the Support Us tab of the website, including downloads like the brochure and talking points. We also finally got our non-profit charitable giving up and running. That's also on the Support tab as well. We get about 97% of all donations -- the Qgiv takes about 3%. However, there's a checkbox that says "assist us with transaction fees" that is checked 80% of the time which means the donor will cover our cost -- usually they pay an extra \$1. Plan would be to really push this during National Day of Giving in December
