1. Opening

- The meeting was called to order.
- **Minutes:** A motion was made to review and approve the meeting minutes from December 20, 2025.
 - **Motion:** Accepted.

2. Treasurer's Report (Dave)

- **Financials:**
 - Review of deposits from recent registrations and sponsorships.
 - Sponsorship revenue was noted as down year-over-year, but the golf outing helped offset the shortfall.
 - Uniform expenses have increased due to a higher number of teams and rising costs of goods.
 - Charter dues increased significantly (Little League dues increased by approx. 45%).
- **Sponsorships:** The board will divide the sponsor list, with each member contacting ~10 potential sponsors.
- **Motion to Accept Report:** Accepted.

3. Little League Report

- **Enrollment:** Registration is currently at ~50% of expected numbers. Registration closes on **February 15**.
- **Volunteers:**
 - Softball: 11 coaches signed up (sufficient).
 - Baseball: 22 coaches signed up (need more).
 - T-Ball: 16 coaches signed up (need ~6 more).
- **Safety:** Little League has introduced a new "Safe to Play" safety plan. A new Little League-designed First Aid and Safety course is now mandatory annually for all volunteers.
- **Upcoming Events & Needs:**
 - **Assessment Day:** Scheduled for **February 21** at Center Court.
 - **Work Party:** Scheduled for this Sunday (11:00 AM – 2:00 PM) at the indoor facility to fix nets and clamps.
 - **Coordinators Needed:** Opening Day Parade, Trenton Thunder Night, Photo Night.
 - **Division Coordinators Needed:** Volunteers needed for Softball and Baseball division coordination.

4. Babe Ruth Report

- Registration is open.
- Evaluations are TBD pending final registration numbers.

5. Competitive Travel Report

- Uniforms are currently being ordered.
- Practices are underway at Center Court and other locations.

6. Snack Shack Report

- **Maintenance:**
 - Ray Dolly is addressing repairs for the water line and hot water heater.
 - Regulators will be installed in the bathrooms.
 - Grease trap cleaning and professional cleaning (Alberto) are scheduled for early February.
- **Equipment:** A new water fountain with a bottle filler has been installed.
- **Operations:**
 - Food and cleaning supply costs are being priced out.
 - **POS System:** The board decided to retain Clover as the POS system due to better rates compared to competitors.

7. New Business

- **Field Rehabilitation:**
 - **Scope:** Upgrades planned for Pezzicola, Colavita, Hughes, and Carroll fields, including new infields, lip removal, and drainage improvements. Carroll and Colvaita will be converted to multi-purpose softball and baseball fields to allow more softball at Central Park.
 - **Cost:** Approximately \$45,000 (paid by the Association; no cost to the township).
 - **Timeline:** Work is scheduled to begin in March, weather permitting.

- **Fundraising:** Fence signs and home plate plaques will be sold to families to help offset costs.
- **Center Court Partnership:**
 - LTJBSA has entered into a one-year agreement with Center Court as the official training partner.
 - **Key Benefits:**
 - Assessment Day will be hosted at Center Court.
 - Discounted rates for LTJBSA members.
 - Access to Center Court coaches for clinics and training assistance.
 - Facility use for practices and rainouts.
